COVID

It has been brought to our attention that there may be a few cases of COVID in Tahitian Gardens. At this time **MASKS** will be **REQUIRED** to enter any facility on the property and social distancing **MUST** take place at all times (6 feet at the least). You will need to sanitize any areas that you will be utilizing. If you choose to enter any common facilities please be aware that you are potentially exposing yourself to illness and you take sole responsibility in entering the facility. Please be aware that if cases in Tahitian Gardens start to rise these guidelines will be reviewed.

FROM THE MANAGERS DESK

The blue painted circles on the buildings have the water shut offs located under them. Each water shut off has a small tag that has the unit letter(s) on it.

If you are an owner in Tahitian Gardens Condominium and you feel that someone is **TRESPASSING** on the Tahitian Gardens property, please call the Pasco County Sheriff's Department and provide them with the case **#18-044446**. This case number will give the sheriff's department direct access to the **Trespass Agreement Notice** that is on file.

Please do not feed the wildlife. When you feed one animal you attract many more. We have many feral cats in Tahitian Gardens, due to the fact that many residents are feeding them. We have sent letters to these residents advising them to stop feeding them immediately. We have had several reports of sightings of raccoons and opossums this could

possibly be due to people leaving food dishes out for the feral cats.

If you have a parking spot that is shared with a ramp going to the sidewalk, can you please park far enough back that if someone needs to use the ramp they can still access it.

Please be sure that you **DO NOT** have any flags out in the common area unless you have recently planted new sod or put down grass seed. If you are blocking off the lawn due to new sod or grass seed please let the office know.

Regularly scheduled board meetings will be held in person and via Zoom. The information to join the meeting via Zoom will be printed on the agendas. The agendas are posted on the bulletin boards and the website 48 hours prior to the meeting date. If you are joining the meeting via zoom you will be muted upon arrival and will remain muted. You will also be required to state your name, and unit number/address prior to speaking. Only unit owners can speak during Board of Directors meetings.
